

COVID-19 RACETRACK GUIDELINES

Several requirements will be in place and participants are asked to please follow them, as this is the first step in showing that the speedway can abide by the specified guidelines in order to have a racing season.

Preparation:

- In order to continue keeping our county safe, please clean and disinfect all equipment prior to arrival at the facility.
- It is highly recommended that all trucks, trailers, motorhomes, personal vehicles be actively disinfected through a wipe-down process by individual attendees prior to arrival to Stockton 99 Speedway.

Travel to:

- All team members should travel and attend together within the same vehicle.

Pre-Event:

- If a participant or team member is sick or displays symptoms of COVID19- STAY HOME
Symptoms include fever, muscle pain, cough, headache, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, sore throat, loss of taste or smell, chills or repeated shaking with chills.
- Participants should wash their hands with soap and water after being in a public place, after blowing their nose, coughing, or sneezing, preparing and/or consuming food.
- Participants should avoid touching their faces.
- All 2020 license application, W9, vehicle registration, and COVID19 waiver/release forms MUST be completed BEFORE arriving to Stockton 99 Speedway.

Practice Fees:

- \$40.00 per person

Race Day Fees:

- Stockton 99 Speedway divisions
- \$100 2020 license application for ALL drivers (REQUIRED in order to race)
- \$40.00 Pit Pass per person member - All Ages

Upon arrival at Stockton 99 Speedway:

- Participants will arrive together in the same vehicle. Participants will be requested to exit the tow vehicle to check in together upon arrival and then will be escorted to a designated pit area.
- Participants will be required to sign the standard waiver/release, as well as, an additional COVID19 waiver/release. Do NOT exit your vehicle to walk up to the Pit Registration Booth, you will be directed to exit your vehicle when upon arrival.
- No personal vehicles will be permitted in the pits
- Participants will have their temperature taken at time of check in

- Participants are required to have hand sanitizer and disinfecting wipes available for each team pit stall.
- Participants will remain in their designated pit area and will adhere to the 6' Social Distancing requirement from other participants.
- Participants will be allowed in the spectator area to watch their respective team car when it is on the track, but will need to vacate the area when their car exits the track.
- Participants will be allowed to bring their own food & beverages (no alcohol, no glass and no open flame bbq's)
- Face masks are mandatory.

Event:

- Staff will report on site 1 hour before pit gates open to be prepped on new protocols and procedures regarding COVID19.
- Officials will communicate with Participants over the PA system.
- No general admission will be available.
- Common areas will be sanitized routinely.
- Hand sanitizer will be available in common areas for all Participants and staff members.

Special Considerations:

- If you are or live with someone over the age of 65 or with underlying medical conditions, please consider staying home or be prepared to self quarantine upon your return.
- Hugs, handshakes, & close contact are discouraged at this time.

We understand this is a lot to take in and to ask of our race teams, however, our primary concern is to keep all participants and our County safe during these challenging times. Thank you for your support and understanding.
